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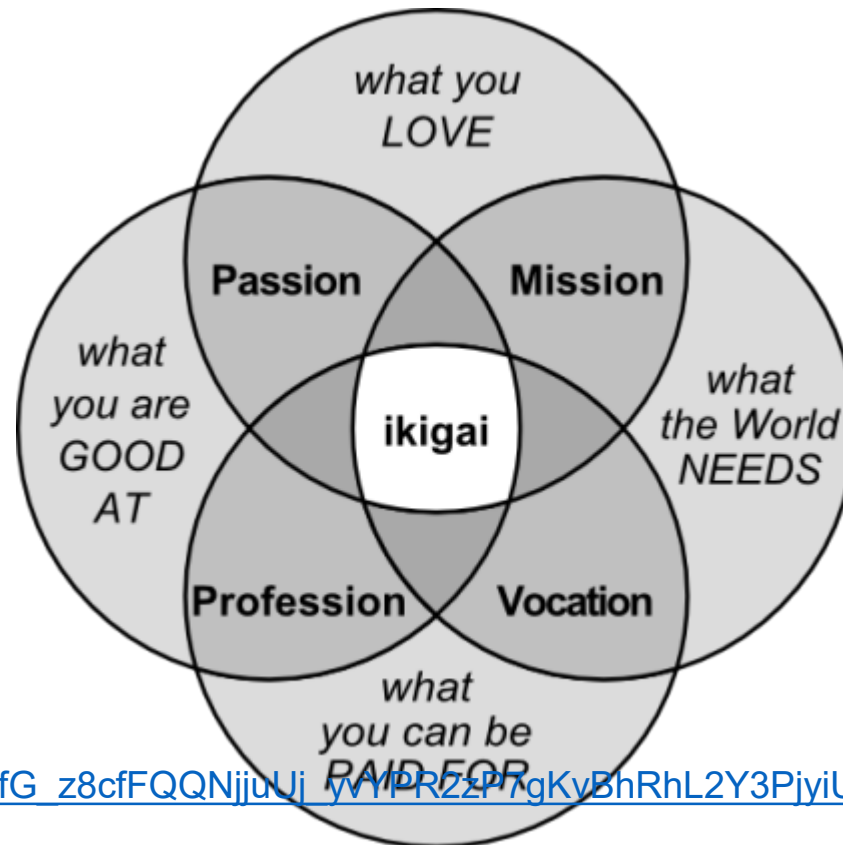
# What is student centred learning?

- recognizes that each student is unique and has different learning needs, styles, and interests
- engages students as designers of their own learning process to draw from their individual needs, interests, and abilities
- creates a flexible and personalized learning environment in which all students feel valued and empowered to participate in hands-on activities, group discussions, and problem-solving exercises
- teacher is facilitator, helping students explore and understand their ideas with an emphasis on formative feedback and self-reflection to understand progress and identify areas for improvement
- students take ownership of their own learning to develop a deeper understanding of the material, build their confidence, and become more self-directed learners
- can foster a love of learning and a lifelong commitment to personal and professional growth.

# What is competence learning?

- **A pedagogical approach that focuses on developing students' practical abilities and skills.**
- **The goal of competence learning is to prepare students for real-world situations by giving them hands-on experience and opportunities to apply what they have learned.**
- **Teachers serve as facilitators and coaches, guiding students as they work on projects, solve problems, and develop their competencies.**
- **Assessment is also an important aspect of competence learning, as it helps students reflect on their progress and identify areas for improvement.**
- **Designing engaging and meaningful activities that allow students to apply their knowledge and skills in authentic contexts.**
- **Encouraging student-led projects and providing opportunities for self-reflection and feedback can also help support a competence-based learning environment.**

# Why is competence learning important?

- **Rapidly changing and increasingly complex world requires focus on the development of practical skills and real-world applications**
- **Students become more confident and capable problem-solvers**
- **Students become more self-directed learners to gain transferable skills such as critical thinking, collaboration, and communication**
- **Students take responsibility for their own learning, setting their own goals and planning their own pathways to success, where most jobs require a combination of technical expertise, problem-solving skills, and the ability to adapt and learn in real-time**
- **Students are better prepared to navigate the challenges and opportunities of the modern world and to pursue meaningful and fulfilling careers.**

- **engaging, purposeful and meaningful learning experiences rooted in the needs, interests, experiences and aspirations of the young people**
- **directly, collaboratively and creatively addressing and resolving the wicked problems of our age is positive and constructive.**
- **inviting them to contribute the what, why and how of their learning**
- **requiring students to take increasing responsibility for their learning to promote ownership of lifelong competence development.**
- **activating students as value creators in their communities builds confidence, belonging and a sense of responsibility.**
